Public Hearing
April 30th, 2014

The Port Royal Town Council met on Wednesday, April 30th for a public hearing on the proposed boundary line agreement between the town and the county.

Members present were Mayor Long, Bill Wick, Jim Heimbach, Bill Henderson, and Della Mills.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

A quorum was established.

A copy of the advertisement was in the *Caroline Progress* for two consecutive weeks prior to the meeting. A copy of the amended agreement was available on the Town's website, posted on the bulletin board outside the town hall, and available for review at the Clerk's office and at the library.
